

MUHAMMAD DOES NOT EXPLAIN, INTERPRET,
OR ANTICIPATE QURAN; JUST DELIVER & FOLLOW.

Hadith & Sunna advocates claim that Hadith & Sunna are needed to explain Quran.

However, Quran teaches that God is the teacher of Quran; that God will put Quran into the hearts of believers regardless of their mother tongue; and that Muhammad will not explain Quran. Documents are shown below:

God is the teacher of Quran (55: 1-2) ﴿الرَّحْمَنُ ﴿١﴾ عَلَّمَ الْقُرْآنَ ﴿٢﴾﴾

أَعْجَبَنِي وَعَرَبِيٌّ قُلُّهُ هُوَ الَّذِي نَامَنُوا هَدَىٰ وَشَفَاءٌ وَالَّذِينَ لَا يُؤْمِنُونَ
فِي آيَاتِنَاهُمْ وَفَرَّوهُ وَعَلَيْهِمْ عَسَىٰ أُولَٰئِكَ ينادون من مكان بعيد

"Whether it came down in non-Arabic or Arabic, say, 'For those who believe, it is a guidance and healing. As for the disbelievers, they will be deaf and blind to it.'" (41: 44)

﴿لَا تَجْرِدْ لِيَدَيْكَ لِآيَاتِنَا لِلْجُلِّيَّةِ ﴿١٦﴾ إِنَّ عَلَيْنَا جَمْعَهُ وَقُرْآنَهُ ﴿١٧﴾ فَإِذَا قَرَأَهُ فَأَتَّبِعْ
قُرْآنَهُ ﴿١٨﴾ ثُمَّ إِنَّ عَلَيْنَا بَيَانَهُ ﴿١٩﴾﴾
